The Holy Gospel according to St Matthew the 22nd Chapter.

22 Jesus spoke to them again in parables, saying: ² "The kingdom of heaven is like a king who prepared a wedding banquet for his son. ³ He sent his servants to those who had been invited to the banquet to tell them to come, but they refused to come. 4 "Then he sent some more servants and said, 'Tell those who have been invited that I have prepared my dinner: My oxen and fattened cattle have been butchered, and everything is ready. Come to the wedding banquet.' 5 "But they paid no attention and went off one to his field, another to his business. ⁶ The rest seized his servants, mistreated them and killed them. ⁷ The king was enraged. He sent his army and destroyed those murderers and burned their city. 8 "Then he said to his servants, 'The wedding banquet is ready, but those I invited did not deserve to come. ⁹ So go to the street corners and invite to the banquet anyone you find.' 10 So the servants went out into the streets and gathered all the people they could find, the bad as well as the good, and the wedding hall was filled with guests. 11 "But when the king came in to see the guests, he noticed a man there who was not wearing wedding clothes. ¹² He asked, 'How did you get in here without wedding clothes, friend?' The man was speechless. 13 "Then the king told the attendants, 'Tie him hand and foot, and throw him outside, into the darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.' ¹⁴ "For many are invited, but few are chosen."

Church Council Minutes, September 2023

The West Prairie church council met Wednesday, September 13. Members attending were Julie Reimann, Jan Reimann, Cindy Sarver, Jodi Fjeld, Terry Durby, and Lisa Durby. Caroll Carson and Pastor Tony attended also.

Julie called the meeting to order and a motion to approve the agenda was made by Terry, with a second by Cindy. Motion approved. Pastor Tony led devotions based on Obidiah Chapter 1 verses 3-4.

Pastor Tony presented his monthly report. A Bible Club Bible study group has been started. He will attend the annual retreat September 18-20th, and the LCMC convention in October. He asked to consider purchasing "Peace Came to Earth" for Advent, and a new grief share program is available. A motion to approve the report was made by Jodi, seconded by Jan, and approved.

The Secretary's report was read and approved.

The Treasurer's report was presented. Income for August was \$5, 639.74 and expenses were \$12,231.65. Expenses included \$4,125.00 for the second half of our budgeted Benevolences. Jan made a motion to approve the report, seconded by Jodi, approved.

Old Business

- The Sunday school room flooring has been installed.
- Twelve trees have been replaced with 3 more to do.
- Discussion was held on material and color choices for the ramp project. The ramp trim color will be Lava Rock, with the center being the Tiki Torch color. The inner rail and the top rail will be the same color as the trim. Vertical spindles will be added to the rail. Some concrete will have to be replaced. Cindy made a motion that the remaining money from the Sharp donation be used to pay for the concrete. 2nd by Jodi, approved.
- Ryan Mullins has accepted the Treasurer's position. Terry made a motion to appoint Ryan as the new treasurer effective October 1st, with Caroll transitioning out of his current position by October 31st. Jan seconded the motion, approved.
- Servers should be notified that there will be additional guests at the October 15th service due to the Issacson family visiting.
